**Prevent Duty Policy**

Since 01/07/15, the Prevent Duty commenced, we have ensured that we have due regard to the need to prevent people/children being drawn into terrorism:

The government has defined extremism in the Prevent strategy as: *“vocal or active opposition to fundamental British Values, including democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty and mutual respect and tolerance of different faiths and beliefs.”*

As an early year’s provider, we have a critical part to play. We care for some of the most vulnerable and impressionable members of society. In England, the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) accordingly places clear duties on providers to keep children safe and promote their welfare. We are following these duties.

We are committed to protecting children in our care. We remain alert to any safeguarding and child protection issues in the child’s life at home or elsewhere and will respond appropriately and responsibly if we have concerns.

As an early year’s provider, we are working to promote children’s welfare and preventing radicalisation and extremism.

**Procedure**

- We assess any risk to children we care for in relation to being drawn into terrorism.
- We protect children from being drawn into terrorism by having robust safeguarding policies in place.
